### **How to Give Entry**

- 1. All entries for U13, U17 and Open Events should be sent online on (<a href="www.mbasso.in">www.mbasso.in</a>) & further the Google form for the Sub Junior, Junior and Open events to be filled and the payment Screen shot to be uploaded.
- Entries for Veterans events to be sent through the Google Form for VETERANS ONLY.
   ( Combination events provision is not available on mbasso.in )
   Provision to upload the payment detail is there in the same google form for Veterans.

Entry Fee shall be accepted only ONLINE. Respective Google form needs to be filled and the Payment Transaction Number Screen Shot needs to be compulsorily uploaded to confirm the Entry ( pl note the transaction number should be visible in the screen shot)

### RULES, REGULATION & GENERAL INFORMATION

### **ABOUT THE TOURNAMENT**

- 1) The tournament is open to players from Maharashtra State Only.
- 2) The Tournament will commence from Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and will conclude on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2023 at Andheri Sports Complex. Munshi Nagar, Andheri West Maharashtra. 400058
- Play is scheduled to commence at 9.00 am, subject to change. Final Schedule updates shall be announced through the Tournament portal on or before 15<sup>th</sup> May. 2023
- 4) This Tournament will be conducted as per the rules and regulations for tournaments as laid down by BWF and BAI. The decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding on all players.

## **HOW TO SEND THE ENTRIES**

1) U13, U17 and Open event Individual entries must be sent by online – <a href="https://www.mbasso.in">www.mbasso.in</a> additionally the Respective Google form for the Junior/Open participants should be filled and submitted along with the entry fees.

Veteran Masters Combination events entry shall be submitted through Veteran Google form, which will have the option for entry fee payment and its Screen shot upload.

No Telephonic / Mail or verbal would be accepted.

Entry fees should be paid online through goggle forms along with the entry Only. QR Scan code is provided in the respective Google forms.

2) Last date of entries is 10<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Last date of Withdrawal 11<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

## **ABOUT THE DRAWS**

- 1) List of entries received shall be displayed on Maharashtra Badminton Association website at www.mbasso.in
- 2) Draws and fixtures using Tournaments Software and as per the revised regulations of BWF will be put up on the notice board as well as displayed on Maharashtra Badminton Association website on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and one day before at the Tournament Venue





### **HOW THE TOURNAMENT IS GOING TO BE CONDUCTED**

- 1) Line Judges may not be appointed for the matches till Semifinals. Players will have to work as line judges whenever called by the Tournament Officials
- 2) Each Competitor must report to the Hon. Referee on his a1 hr before the scheduled time and on arrival at the venue of the tournament. Players failing to report on the court when called by the Hon. Referee, are liable to be disqualified.
- 3) Clothing during play must be as per the new regulations issued by B.A.I. Advertising on the clothing is allowed as per BWF rules
- 4) Yonex brand shuttles, approved by MBA will be used.
- 5) Next day matches fixtures will be displayed online
- 6) Scoring format for the event will be decided once the draws are displayed.
- 7) Players must not leave the tournament hall without checking the fixtures of their next match.
- 8) Any disputes arising on the Court should be raised to the Umpire only, in a disciplined and respectable manner. Any kind of Objectionable Behavior shall be dealt with strict action and suspension if required.
- 9) In case of a Dispute / Objection the Umpire can approach the Tournament Referee for clarity and then announce his decision. Players are not allowed to move out of the court without permission of the Umpire, nor approach the Tournament Referee Directly. Players can Share their concerns with the Referee after the match. The players can Approach the Referee in case of any clarification required. Game Related disputes shall be settled as per standard BAI /BWF rules.
- 10) In case of any doubts of scoring system or point system please ask the Referee before the start of the Play
- 11) Except as otherwise provided in the Rules, by the Tournament Committee, the laws of Badminton Association of India will apply to this Tournament.
- 12) Entry fees once paid is not refundable.
- 13) Feather Shuttles selected by the Organizing Committee will be used for the matches.
- 14) The Referee shall be the final authority regarding walk-over, which cannot be claimed by any participant as a matter of right.
- 15) Decision of the Tournament Controller and Tournament Referee in all Matters connected with the Tournament shall be final.
- 16) Valid ID card (for Name and Age ) should be produced when demanded by referee

\*\* For Semi Finals and Finals, it is Compulsory for all Players to wear the T-shirts as per BAI Guidelines for Doubles

All Players shall abide by the Rules of the Venue Club and Badminton Court Rules at all times. Any player causing any Intentional Damage to The Property or Reputation of the Court premises and GMBA or MBA will be Strictly Delt with Legally and shall be disqualified with immediate effect.
